Newcomers' Dinner

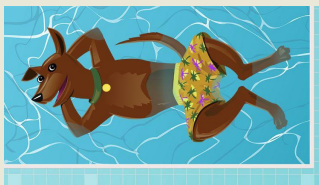

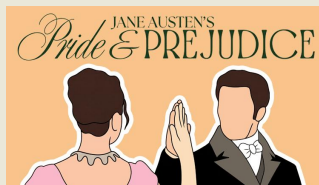

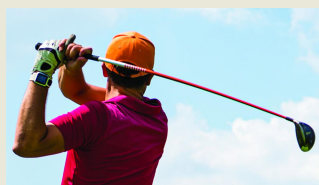
