- ☐ **Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP)** is a mandatory enrollment support program that works with other military and civilian agencies to provide coordinated medical, educational, housing, community support and personnel services to Soldiers who have a special needs Family member.

- ☐ **Family Advocacy Program (FAP)** builds healthy Families and sustains strong communities by providing comprehensive approaches to prevention, identification, and intervention of child and spouse abuse in military Families. - **New Parent Support Program (NPSP)** offers services to expectant parents and parents of newborns through three years of age. The New Parent Support Home Visitors can visit with you at home or can schedule an office visit. Services are tailored to your Family's needs and goals.
