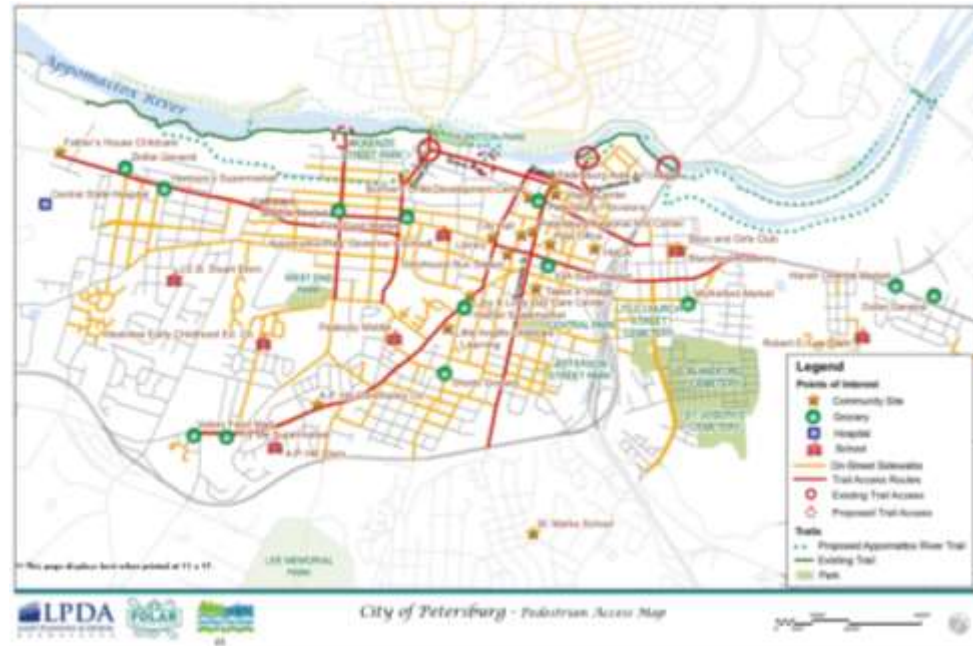
- Collaboration with River Street Market and other community partners
