MTF Restructuring

“Transition Kenner Army Health Clinic outpatient facility to an Active Duty only and Occupational Health clinic (AD/OH). Kenner AHC should maintain extended care hours to include weekend and holiday half-hours. All base support functions and pharmacy workload supporting all beneficiaries will be maintained.”

“It will take time for the supply and demand in a market to reach a balance, therefore transition MTF eligible to commercial providers may require two (2)-to-three (3) plus years to complete depending on local healthcare market conditions and number of enrollees dis-empaneled.”

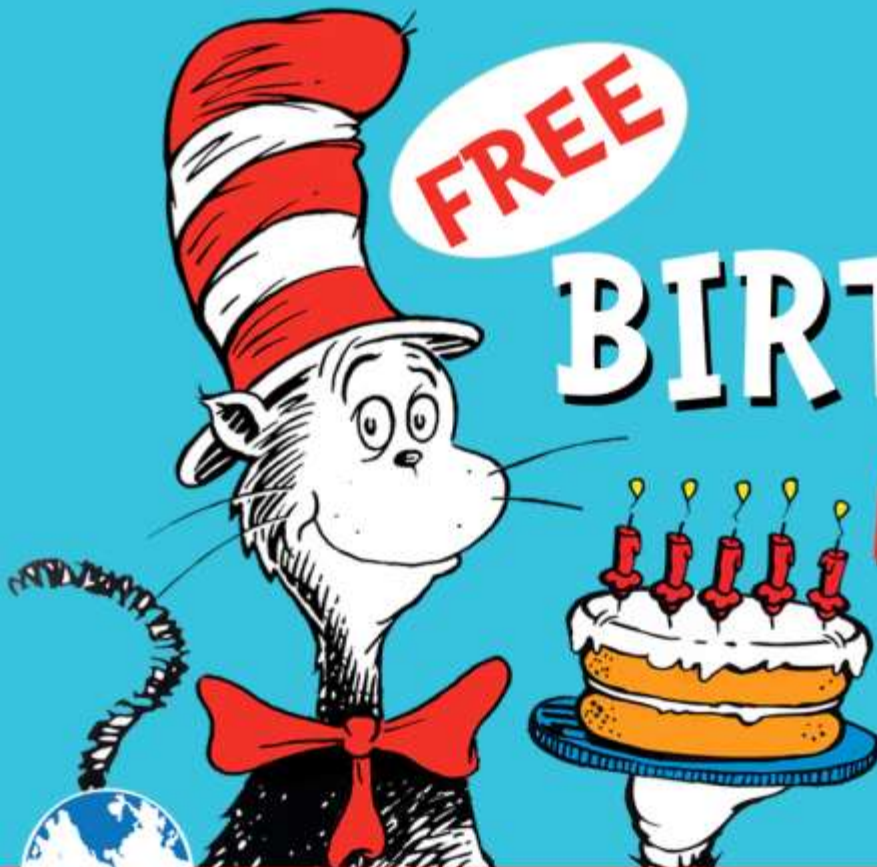

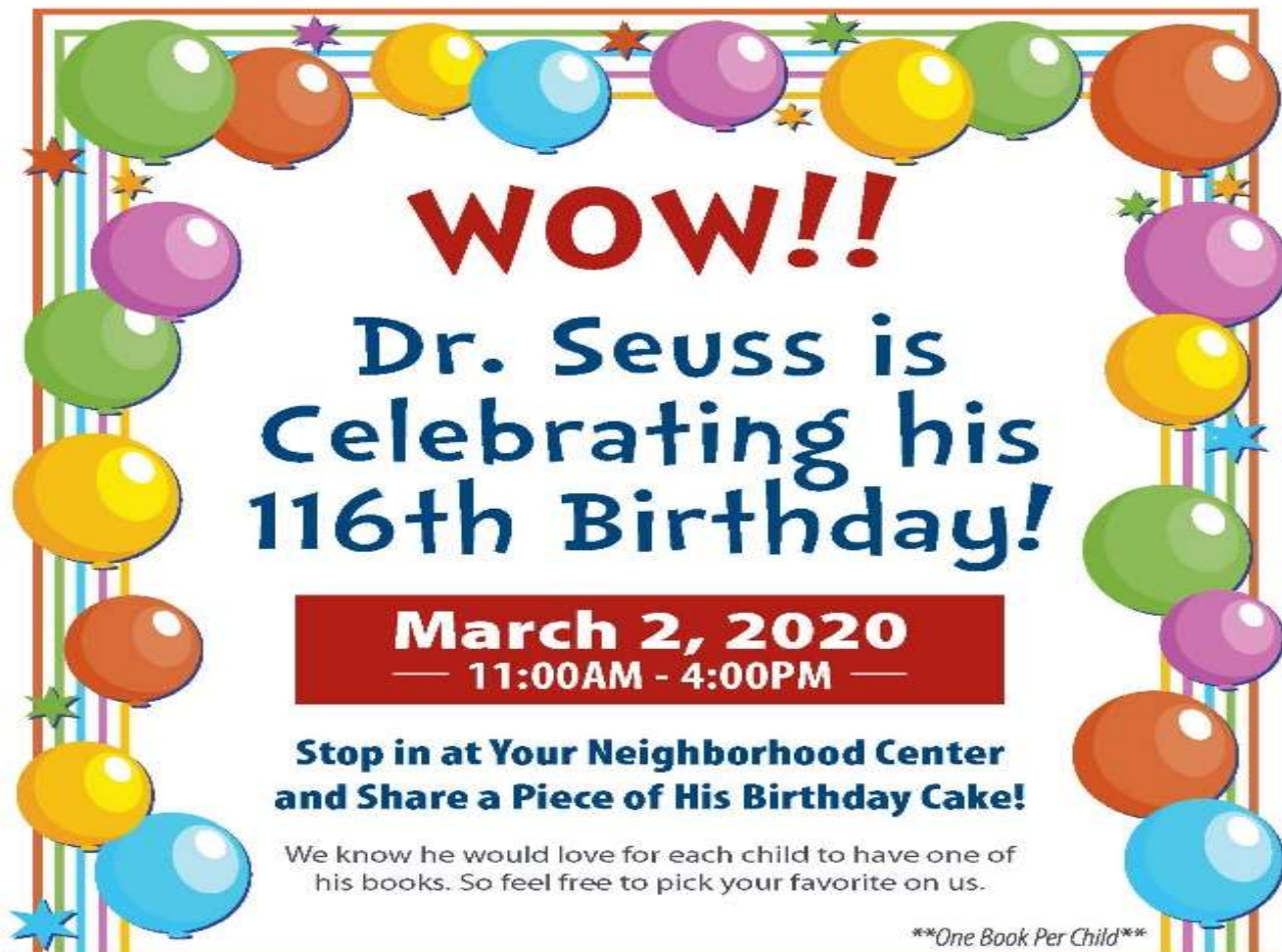
