Home Based Business (HBB)


- Home Based Businesses (HBBs) allow spouses to work from their Army quarters by developing rewarding careers for spouses that follow them through PCS moves.
- HBBs are key contributors to the Army Family quality of life. Recent procedural changes is making it quicker and easier to gain approval to operate HBBs on-post.
- Registration of a HBB to operate on-post is mandatory, noncompliance could result in losing on-post housing privileges.
- HBB approval process should take no more than 60 days.
- If you are contemplating to operate an HBB on post and/or aren't yet approved, now is the time to get official. Go to: lee.armymwr.com and/or contact your housing representatives or FMWR Admin Office on post for assistance.
