SUMMARY	Fort Gregg - Adams / Lee	PUBLIC/OFF POST SCHOOL DISTRICTS
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- 1 School-age children who live on Fort Gregg-Adams attend Prince George County Public Schools.
- 2 Five additional school districts surround Fort Gregg-Adams.
- 3 School attendance zones determine the school a student will attend based on their address. Out of district transfers are not generally approved.
- 4 Fort Gregg-Adams School Support Services can assist in determining the school your home is zoned for as well as private and home school information.
- 5 Your child must be five years old on or before Sept 30 to be eligible to enroll in public schools.
- 6 Enroll your children as soon as possible. After you enroll, return to the school and provide the school with updated contact information.
- 7 School Liason Officer can also help with post-secondary opportunities and resources.
