New Career Pathways & Educational Opportunities Available Virginia's G3 Tuition Aid Program

 G3 is a tuition assistance program for any Virginia resident who qualifies for in-state financial aid and whose family income is less than or equal to 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (roughly an income of \$100,000 for a family of four)

• G3 aid covers community college programs in the areas of Healthcare, Early Childhood Education, Information Technology, Public Safety and Skilled Trades.

How does G3 tuition assistance work?

G3 assistance makes up the difference between what federal or state financial aid pays for and the cost of tuition, fees and books. G3 can help pay the remaining tuition balance after all non-loan aid has been applied. Participants can also receive a student incentive support grant of \$900 if enrolled full time (12 credits).



If you're eligible to take part in TRICARE Open Season, you have three choices:

- Stay in your plan: If you want to stay in your current TRICARE health plan, you don't have to take any action. You'll continue in your current health plan through 2022—or as long as you're eligible.
- Enroll in a plan: If you're eligible for TRICARE Prime® or TRICARE Select[®] but not enrolled, you can enroll in a plan now.
- Change plans. If you're already enrolled in a TRICARE Prime option or TRICARE Select, you can switch health plans and switch between individual and family enrollment.

Booster for Beneficiaries

Booster Dose available for Kenner beneficiaries

A booster shot is now available for beneficiaries at Kenner Army Health Clinic who have completed their primary Pfizer and Moderna (six months after second shot) or Johnson & Johnson (2 months after shot) vaccine series AND meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 65 years of age and older and residents in long term care facilities should receive a booster dose
- 50-64 years of age with underlying medical conditions should receive a booster dose
- 18-49 years of age with <u>underlying medical conditions</u>
- 18-64 years of age who live or work in a <u>high-risk setting</u>

Family Medicine offers the booster for eligible beneficiaries by appointment only on Fridays between 1-5 p.m. Please call the Appointment Line to schedule your booster dose at 1-866-533-5242, option 1.


