





- What: Warrior Training Advancement Course (training to become a Veterans Service Representative)
- When: 25 January 1 April 2021
- > Where: Bunker Hall, 2601 Quarter Road, Building 12500, Rm. C-128 (Army Logistic University)
- Why: The 10-week Career Skills Program is offered by the Department of Veteran Affairs, Veterans Benefits Administration, in partnership with SFL-TAP, to provide transitioning service members a career opportunity as a Veteran Service Representative (VSR). Successful completion of the program will lead to a GS-7 position at one of the Regional Veteran Affairs Offices Service Centers with an advancement to GS-10 position upon the completion of the probationary period.


